I, Robina Contreras, declare:

I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration.

I began working at Zūm as a driver in the California area in approximately October of 2018. I worked 15-20 hours a week. I stopped driving for Zūm in approximately December 2019, because I began work as a full-time employee elsewhere.

I agreed to serve as a named plaintiff in this case in August of 2019. It has now been approximately two and a half years that I have been involved in this litigation, helping to bring claims on behalf of California drivers providing transportation services to Zūm.

4. I was motivated to contact an attorney and get involved in this case because I had been reading and educating myself on how gig economy companies such as Uber, Lyft, and Zūm, had been using the independent contractor to exploit workers (by minimizing pay, while still controlling these workers). Based on the control exerted by Zūm, I realized I was misclassified as an independent contractor. For example, while working for Zūm, I would be frustrated that I would be told to pick up a passenger at a specific time and would wait 20-25 minutes and then would only learn, after waiting that period of time, through Zūm that the passenger had cancelled the ride earlier that morning. While I would receive some form of cancellation fee, I was ultimately losing money due to wait time and because the cancelation could have a cascading effect on my schedule for the rest of the day.

- Throughout this case, I have provided my attorneys with information relating to my work for Zūm. In addition to providing my attorneys with information regarding my work for Zūm, I also spoke and corresponded with my attorneys regarding the settlement efforts in this case. My attorneys have kept me apprised of settlement negotiations in this case, and I have reviewed the settlement agreement. I understand my role as a class representative of the proposed settlement class is to look out for the interests of other California Zūm drivers and I have taken that duty seriously. I have carefully reviewed the settlement materials, and I believe this settlement is in the best interests of the settlement class.
- Cumulatively, I estimate I spent at least 10-15 hours speaking to my attorneys about my work and the case and going over the settlement terms.

- 7. As I was working for Zūm at the beginning of this case, I feared retaliation for my participation in the case. I was also worried about having my name on this case and how that might affect future employment. I've had these concerns since the case was filed, but I was willing to do it anyway because I wanted to make a difference for my fellow drivers and to challenge the independent contractor model that Zūm and other gig economy companies have been using.
- 8. I am very proud of my involvement in this litigation and am proud to lend my name to this settlement. I joined this litigation because companies like Zūm should not be allowed to get away with unlawfully exerting control over workers who they have classified as independent contractors, creating a horribly stressful and unfair work environment, while at the same time depriving those workers of their employee rights. I have been willing to lend my good name to this case because I think it's important to stand up for your beliefs, even if it means taking a risk to my personal interests and reputation.

I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
